Presenters

Dr. Faizan Alawi

Dr. Faizan Alawi earned his D.D.S. from McGill University in Montreal, Canada. He completed his training in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at New York Hospital Queens. Dr. Alawi is currently the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs at the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine. He is Professor of Pathology at Penn Dental Medicine, and in the Departments of Dermatology and Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania Perelman School of Medicine. Dr. Alawi is a recipient of the Christian R. and Mary F. Lindback Award for Distinguished Teaching; the highest teaching honor awarded by the University of Pennsylvania. He is also a three-time recipient of the Penn Dental Medicine Basic Science Award for Excellence in Teaching. He is the author of over 160 peer-reviewed manuscripts, book chapters, and unique abstracts. Dr. Alawi is a current member of the Executive Council of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. He is also Vice-President of the Oral Pathology and Medicine section of the International Association of Dental Research, and Chair-Elect of the Academic Affairs Section of the American Dental Education Association. He is the Pathology Section Editor for the journal Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine, Oral Pathology, Oral Radiology.

Frederic Barnett, DMD

Dr. Barnett received his DMD degree in 1978 and his Certificate in Endodontics in 1981, both from the University of Pennsylvania, School of Dental Medicine. He received his Board Certification in Endodontics in 1988, has served as the Director of Postdoctoral Endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania, and is currently the Chairman and Program Director of the IB Bender Postdoctoral Endodontic Program at Albert Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia. Dr. Barnett has written numerous scientific and clinical papers and has lectured nationally and internationally on the Treatment of Endodontic Infections, Revascularization, Dental Trauma, Root Resorption and Contemporary Endodontic Treatment. Dr. Barnett is a Fellow of the International Association of Dental Traumatology, the International College of Dentists and the American College of Dentists. He received the Edward M. Osetek Educator Award in 2017 from the AAE and the 2018 Community Service Award from the Philadelphia Business Journal for providing endodontic services for the homeless in Philadelphia. He currently serves on the Advisory Board of the Dental Traumatology Journal, is a Director of the International Association of Dental Traumatology and a former Associate Editor of the Journal of Endodontics. Dr. Barnett has been in private practice in Endodontics from 1981-2011.

Dr. Asma Khan

Dr. Asma Khan received her dental degree from India, her PhD in Neuroscience from University of Maryland and her Certificate in Endodontics from UT Health San Antonio. She completed a Fellowship in Clinical Research at the National Institutes of Health, Bethesda and a Post-Doctoral Fellowship on Neuro-Immune interactions at UT Health San Antonio. She conducts translational and clinical research on the diagnosis and management of pain and of cracked teeth. She uses a basic science approach to examine the role of extracellular vehicles and microRNAs in pain.

Ashraf F. Fouad, BDS, DDS, MS, FACD, FDS RCSEd

Dr. Fouad obtained his DDS, Certificate of Endodontics and MS at the University of Iowa. He served on the faculty and in various administrative roles at University of Connecticut, the University of Maryland, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He is currently Professor and Chair, Department of Endodontics, and Director, Advanced Endodontics Program, at the University of Alabama at
