### Joseph W. (Chip) Marshall III, Esq

### Trustee

Mr. Marshall is a proud Temple alumnus, earning both his undergraduate and law degrees in 1975 and 1979 respectively. Chip serves on the university's Board of Trustees and on Ambler's Board of Visitors, as well as serving on the Rome Board. Currently Chip is the vice chairman of Stevens & Lee, a professional consultancy with nearly 200 lawyers and 40 non-lawyer business and consulting professionals. Prior to his time at Stevens & Lee, Chip was the chairman and CEO of the Temple University Health System. He and his wife Phyllis serve on a variety of boards and non-profits in the Philadelphia region.



### Jennnifer Unis Sullivan, DMD, JD, FCLM

### Keynote Speaker



Dr. Sullivan is the first female dentist in Pennsylvania to earn a law degree and pass the bar. She received her D.M.D. from Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry in Philadelphia, and J.D. from the Thomas Kline School of Law at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh. She co-founded Unis Dental Associates and continues to practice general and cosmetic dentistry as she has over the past 39 years. She has been routinely named one of Pittsburgh's "Top Dentists" in Pittsburgh Magazine as voted by her patients and dental peers. She was appointed to the Pennsylvania State Board of Dentistry by 2 Governors and currently serves as Chair of the State Dental Board. She is an Adjunct Assistant Professor at Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry, and in 2024 she was the recipient of the Temple Kornberg School of Dentistry Outstanding Alumni Award in Leadership. Dr. Sullivan currently serves as the 55th President of the American College of Legal Medicine (ACLM), the first female dentist, and

the third dentist to serve as President. She is a recipient of the ACLM Gold Medal Award, the highest award given to an ACLM member. She is the first female dentist, and only the second dentist to receive this highest honor.

### Faculty Speaker

Dr. Segal completed a 3-year residency in Fixed, Removable and Maxillofacial Prosthodontics at the Veterans Administration Medical center in Wilmington, Delaware in 1983. Dr. Segal had a private practice on Long Island, NY and taught part time at the SUNY at Stony Brook, School of Dental Medicine from 1985 through 2009. In 2009, he accepted a full-time position in the Division of Prosthodontics of the Department of General Dentistry, at the School of Dental Medicine. A year later he was named the Division director. In 2010 he successfully challenged the American Board of Prosthodontists exam. He was given the task of developing a curriculum and preparing the CODA documentation for a postdoctoral program. In 2013 he was named the director of the Advanced Education Program in Prosthodontics and was promoted to Clinical Associate Professor.



In 2015 he accepted a full-time position at the Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry. At Kornberg he directed several courses and became the interim Chair of the Department of Restorative Dentistry in 2018. He became the Chair the following year and in 2024 he was awarded the Donald and Cecilia Platnick Endowed Chair in Restorative Dentistry.

### Dikshitha Shankar, DMD '25 Student Speaker



Dikshitha Shankar was raised in South Florida. She attended the University of Florida for her undergraduate studies and received her Master's in Biomedical Sciences from Barry University before starting at Temple in 2021.

During her time at Temple, Dikshitha has been involved with the Student Council as Class President for her D1 and D2 years and most recently as the 2024-2025 Student Body President. She also served as a mentor through the Kornberg Peer Mentor Program and was the ASDA District 3 Wellness Chair. After graduation, Dikshitha will pursue a GPR in the DC Area.

### Ron Silverman, DDS '72



Major General Ronald D. Silverman was the first U.S. Army officer to command all above-division-level medical forces in a combat zone, serving in Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom from 2006 to 2007. Born in Philadelphia, he earned a BA in History from the University of Wisconsin in 1969 and a DDS from Temple University in 1972.

He served on active duty as a Dental Corps Officer from 1972 to 1975, then joined the Army Reserve in 1976. His assignments included roles at the Pentagon, the Army Surgeon General's office, and the U.S. Army Personnel Command. He commanded the 804th Medical Brigade from 1998 to 2002, overseeing medical missions in the U.S. and abroad.

In 2004, he became commander of the 3rd Medical Command, a deployable theater-level medical headquarters. While deployed, he led Task Force 3d MEDCOM, overseeing medical care for over 150,000 personnel, building combat hospitals, and establishing medical training centers in Iraq.

Dr. Silverman's service contributed to a battlefield survival rate of over 90%. His awards include the Distinguished Service Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), Legion of Merit (with Oak Leaf Cluster), Bronze Star, and Meritorious Service Medal.

Decorated with multiple military honors, including the Distinguished Service Medal and Bronze Star, Dr. Silverman has over 40 years of military service. He continues to serve as a mentor and forensic dentistry consultant. He lives in Florida with his wife, Miriam, and is part of a three-generation legacy of military service.
